Outdoor murals by Dan McWilliams and Sherry Petty adorn the Granby Mining Museum. The magnificence of local artist, Lowell Davis, graces the Jasper County Court House. While visiting Carthage, don't miss the unique styling of world-renowned artist Sam Butcher of the Precious Moments Chapel.

Congressman M.E. Benton.




